- Collected feedback from participants at four stations by planning topic






## **Exit Questionnaire Outcomes**

  - "Will you participate in future events?"


### How did you hear about this meeting?

- Launched online engagement






# Exit Questionnaire Outcomes


- Majority of attendees were white (not Hispanic/Latino), live in rural Orange County, and own their home
